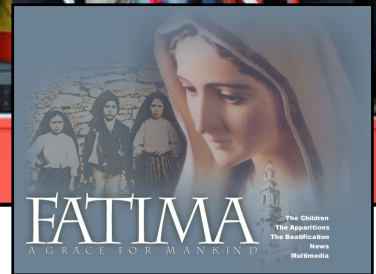

*Archdiocese of Omaha World Youth Day Itinerary**

- August 09:** USA/Lisbon via overnight flight.
- August 10:** Arrive Lisbon and transfer from the airport to the hotel. **(D)**
- August 11:** Full day in Fatima, where Our Lady appeared to the children, then return to Lisbon. **(CB, D)**
- August 12:** Lisbon/Coimbra/Santiago de Compostela. **(CB, D)**
- August 13:** Full day in Santiago featuring the Cathedral of St. James and his relics. **(CB, D)**
- August 14:** Santiago/Avila/Madrid. Upon arrival in Madrid transfer to your hotel with an orientation tour enroute **(CB)**
- August 15:** Possible day trips offered through Corporate Travel for a small fee. To be announced in Fall of 2010. **(CB)**
- August 16:** Your group has the morning free to explore Madrid. This afternoon you join WYD 2011 participants from all around the world for the official WYD Opening Ceremonies. **(CB)**
- August 17:** WYD 2011 activities begin. Be sure to review updates for your assigned Catechesis/Pilgrimage. **(CB)**
- August 18:** WYD 2011 activities throughout the day. The Pope's Welcoming Ceremony is in the evening. **(CB)**
- August 19:** WYD 2011 activities throughout the day, ending with the Stations of the Cross. **(CB)**
- August 20:** Depart for the pilgrimage walk to the overnight vigil site. **(CB)**
- August 21:** This morning, you celebrate Mass with the Holy Father. **(CB)**
- August 22:** Transfer provided to the airport for the flight back to USA. Possible added day(s) if flights are not available due to high demand. Each pilgrim is responsible for any additional costs. You will be informed in advance.

* Itinerary is tentative and subject to final confirmation of group air space and other arrangements.

Pricing Disclaimers

Estimated Prices: All prices listed are estimates only, based on 2009 travel and estimated for 2011. You will receive notice of price adjustments after the base airfare is announced in the Fall of 2010. A final invoice will be issued in the spring of 2011 after airline tickets are issued and air taxes, government fees and fuel surcharges are firm. Also, any currency adjustment will be announced in the spring of 2011. Details about these topics below.

Exchange Rate: Package rates are based on the currency exchange rate of \$1.40 US dollars per 1 Euro and is subject to change.

Base Airfare: The Base Airfare is estimated at \$1,075 per person and could be higher or lower. Eleven months prior to departure, group airfare will be open for booking. Actual Base Airfare may be higher or lower and package prices will be adjusted when actual airfare is known in the Fall of 2010.

Air tax, government fees and fuel surcharges: This amount is in addition to the package price and is subject to change until the airline tickets are issued. The estimated amount of \$350 is based on 2009 travel. This amount can vary significantly depending on the price of fuel at the time airline tickets are issued.

Increase for possible additional nights: Because of very high demand for air seats for World Youth Day, it is possible some passengers may not travel on the dates projected. Additional lodging charges will be the responsibility of the traveler. This situation will be evaluated after group air space is obtained in the Fall of 2010.

Averaging of price increases/decreases: The Archdiocese of Omaha reserves the right to assess increases or decreases in cost based on an average amortized over all participants.

PRICING DISCLAIMERS: See Page #2 for details (page listing the itinerary)

PAYMENT SCHEDULE: In order to meet deposit schedules with suppliers for this tour, Corporate Travel Service asks for prompt payment on the requested dates. The advertised price of is based on a minimum of 44 passengers. Prices are based on tariffs, exchange rates, air line fuel surcharges and taxes in effect when the tour was organized and are subject to increase before tour departure. Price of the tour may have to be adjusted before final payment to reflect any increase in tariffs, fluctuation in exchange rates and/or fuel surcharges. Corporate Travel Service accepts cash, check, money orders and Visa and MasterCard for payment. In order to qualify for the advertised price, traveler must pay entire tour (deposit and final payment) by cash or check. The discount for payment by cash or check will be made after final payments are received.

Deposit \$200 by February 1, 2010 to secure availability and obtain the Early Booking Savings. Additional \$600 due March 15, 2010. Additional \$600 due May 1, 2010; Additional \$500 due August 1, 2010; Additional \$500 due November 1, 2010; Balance due March 1, 2011.

PARENTAL PERMISSION FORM/Minimum Age Requirement

All persons must be at least 16 years or older at the time of travel in order to participate in WYD. (absolutely no exceptions) If pilgrims meet this requirement, but are under the age of 18 by August 1, 2011 special documentation is needed. For a minor under the age of 18 to travel out of the United States without both parents or legal guardians, a notarised affidavit must be obtained and presented to immigration officials upon departure and return to the United States.

CANCELLATION POLICY: All cancellations must be received in writing. Absolutely no exceptions can be granted to the following policy. Cancellations from the time of booking to May 1, 2010 will forfeit \$200 per person deposit. From May 2, 2010 through March 1, 2011, forfeit \$1,400 per person. Any cancellations after March 1, 2011 will be non-refundable. Penalties will be according to the fax or postmark.

STATE DEPARTMENT & OTHER AGENCIES: From time to time the State Department (www.state.gov) and the Centers for Disease Control (www.cdc.gov) and other government agencies and departments issue travel advisories or warnings for one or more of the destinations that you may be visiting on tour. We encourage you to contact these agencies directly to obtain the most current information. Corporate Travel Service cannot change the cancellation terms or conditions based on the issuance of any such warning or advisory or the occurrence of any terror, health or other incident in one or more of the places this tour is scheduled to visit. All cancellation penalties must remain in full force and effect as outlined on the reservation form.

CANCELLATION INSURANCE: We strongly recommend the purchase of travel insurance. This insurance will refund your payments in the event that you must cancel due to illness, death, etc. (some restrictions apply). We offer a special group policy issued by Travel Guard. Insurance premiums cover trip cancellation up to the value of the trip; \$25,000 of medical insurance; and more. Full policy details will be made available to each traveler. The cost for the optional travel insurance depends upon the overall cost of the trip, as outlined below. **To purchase insurance please check that option on the reservation form at the time of booking and include payment of premium with your initial deposit.**

- Trip cost per Person \$ 4,001- \$ 4,500, optional Insurance cost \$160
- Trip cost per Person \$ 4,501- \$ 5,000, optional Insurance cost \$176
- Trip cost per Person \$ 5,001- \$ 5,500, optional Insurance cost \$204

ROOMS: Roommates will be assigned by trip leaders at Archdiocese of Omaha. Rooming will be double (2 to a room). Adults have the opportunity to stay in a single room for additional cost.

CHECKED LUGGAGE: Checked baggage is limited to one bag per person. There can be no exceptions. For most airlines, the one checked bag is limited to **50 pounds and 62 inches** (length + width + height). If

these specifications are exceeded, excess charges may be collected by the airline at the airport. Do not lock baggage you intend to check in at the airport. Please confirm these specifications when you receive your final travel documents, as they can and do change. There is not currently a fee for one checked bag to Europe, but this may change by 2011.

CARRY ON LUGGAGE: You may also bring a small carry-on bag that will fit under an airline seat and on the small parcel racks of the motor coach, which average about 8 inches high by 18 inches deep. It is best if your carry-on bag is soft sided, as the parcel racks on the motor coaches are small.

GRATUITIES: Gratuities for your escort, driver and guides are not included. In Europe it is customary to tip the escort (3) Euros and the driver two (2) Euros per person per day. The tip for the local guides is usually about one (1) Euro for half-day tours and two (2) Euros for full day tours.

PASSPORT: A valid U.S. Passport is required of all passengers. Please apply for your passport immediately as passports are taking a long time to process. **It must be valid for 6 months following the return date of the trip or boarding may be denied or entry into the destination may be forbidden.** Note that it is imperative to have your passport by February 1, 2011, or your reservation may be cancelled with no refund.

TRAVEL DOCUMENTS: Unless otherwise notified, Corporate Travel Service will mail to you, or your Group Leader, a more detailed itinerary and General Information Sheet approximately 2 weeks or 10 days before departure.

ITINERARY: The Itinerary as presented in this brochure is tentative and represents what we are planning for you, however it is subject to confirmations from many organizations. Because of changes in local schedules, we may need to alter specified events, dates and/or venues to better fit the overall plan.

HEALTH REQUIREMENTS: Travelers must be medically and physically fit for this tour. Most tours require significant walking, as motor coaches are not permitted to pick up and drop off in front of major attractions. Should any special assistance be required, traveler agrees to bring a companion capable and willing to assist traveler. Any special medical conditions or equipment must be advised in writing, for evaluation of feasibility, at the time of making your reservation.

GROUP TRAVEL: There are many advantages to traveling with a group (i.e., availability of air seats and hotels during special events, group travel rates, organized special events exclusively for the group, lower admission rates, etc). Travelers, however, must agree to abide by the group's schedule in order to avoid delaying the entire group and must be tolerant and patient with others. Decisions will be made by the Archdiocese of Omaha for the big picture benefit of all Archdiocese travelers

AIR ROUTING: There are no non-stop flights from Omaha to Madrid. There will be at least one connection on all flights either in the USA or in Europe. Because of extremely high demand for World Youth Day, it is possible that passengers may travel by bus to another origin city such as Chicago. Air schedules often have long layovers during World Youth Day and travelers must be prepared to accept this possibility. It is also possible that some passengers may not travel on projected dates. Additional lodging cost will be the responsibility of the traveler.

WYD REGISTRATION FEE: The Archdiocese of Omaha has estimated, and included in the package prices, the WYD registration fee of **\$350**, the fee is subject to change with the final notification from the WYD International Committee. In years past, the registration fee has included entry to all WYD Festival activities, public ground transportation, and a meal plan during the WYD Festival. Actual registration fee should be known by the Fall of 2010 and you will be notified of any increase/decrease.
